Daniel Quintero at the age of 21 was arrested by the members of the Venezuelan National Guard on the way home from a public demonstration. He was brutally tortured and threatened with death. Daniel is one of those brave people who reported the human rights violations committed against him, for which he was threatened again.

I call upon you to investigate thoroughly, independently and impartially Daniel Quintero's complaint about the torture and inhuman treatment he was subjected to and ensure that those who are responsible are brought to justice. I also ask to ensure that all the complaints related to the demonstrations will be investigated independently and impartially. I ask you to protect the victims, witnesses and their families from any kind of violence, threat or intimidation that may arise as a result of the investigation. Finally, I call upon you to ensure that people are free to exercise their rights related to freedom of expression, and that they could enjoy their rights to association without the fear of retaliation.
